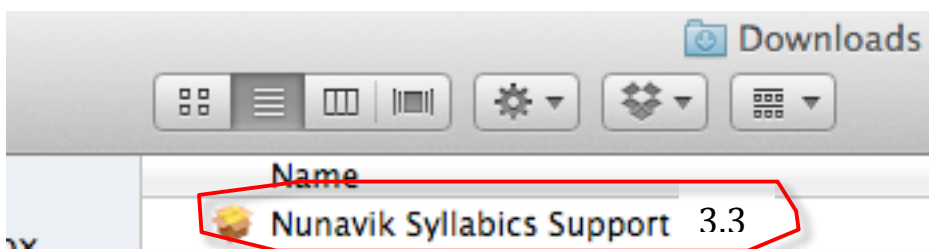


Macintosh Installation

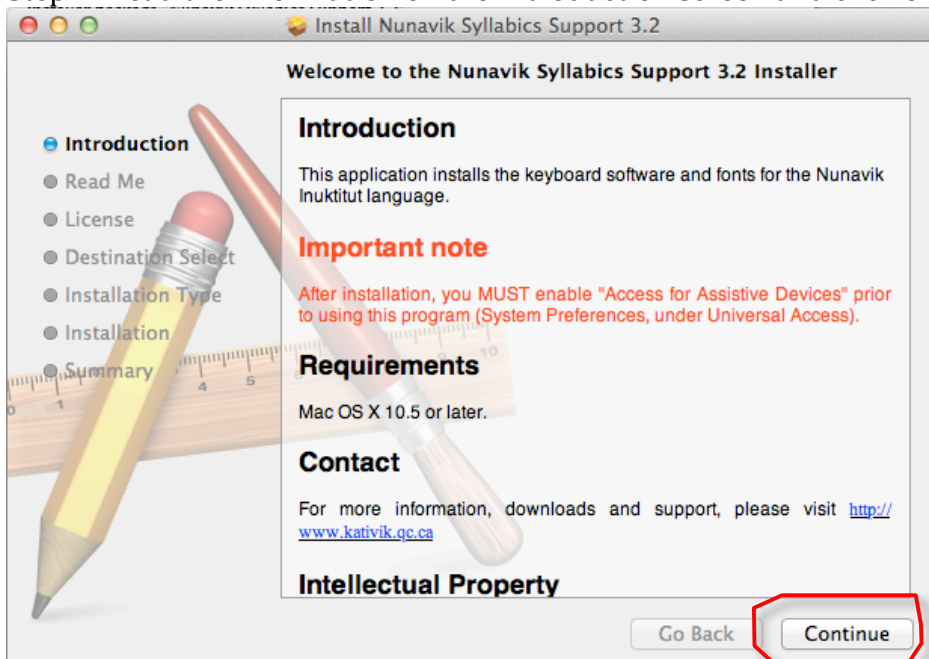
Step 1: Download the installer “Nunavik Syllabics Support 3.3.zip”

Step 2: On your computer, unzip “Nunavik Syllabics Support 3.3.zip” to reveal the installer package “Nunavik Syllabics Support 3.3”



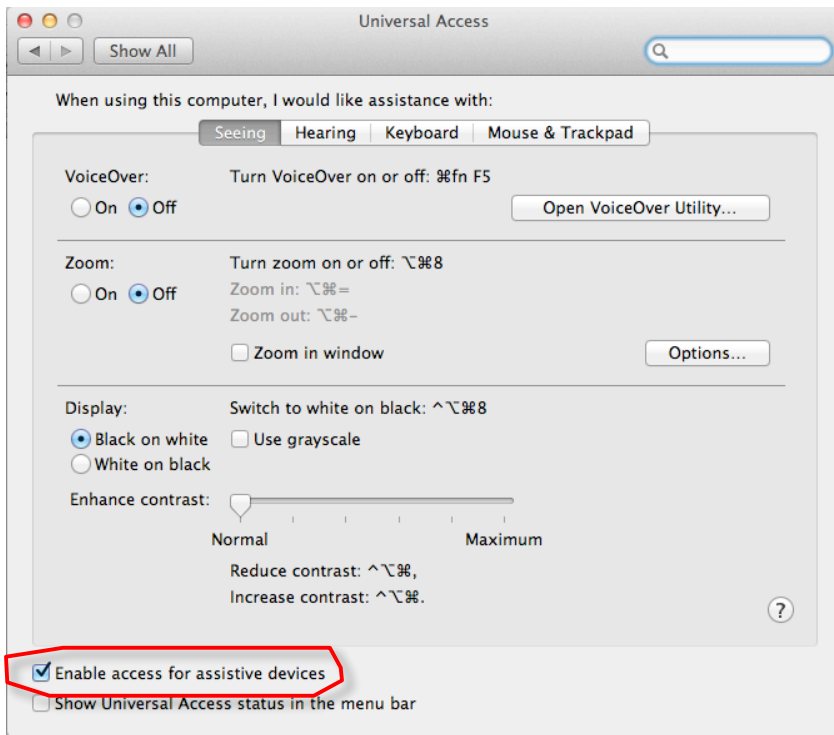
Step 3: Double-click on “Nunavik Syllabics Support 3.3” to launch the installer.

Step 4: Read the information on the Introduction screen and click on “Continue”,

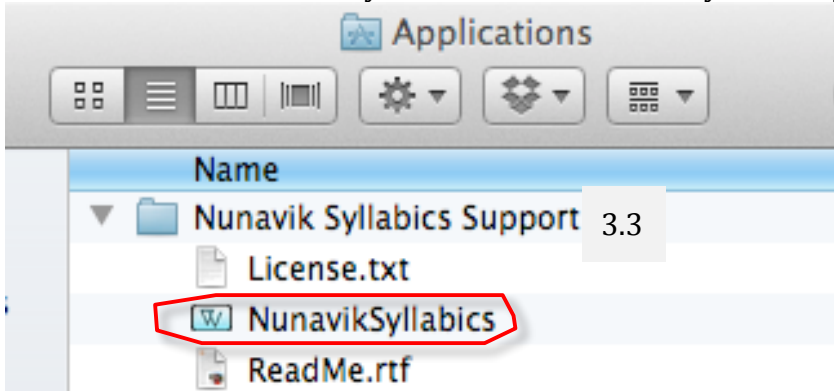


read some more and follow the information on the screens until you see “The installation was successful”.

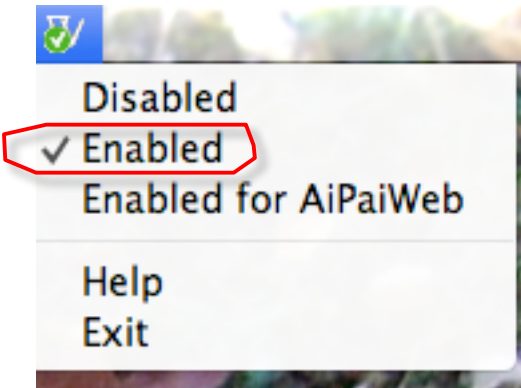
Step 5: Open System Preferences ... Universal Access and check “Enable access for assistive devices”. If you do not perform this step, the keyboard layout will not work



Step 6: Go to “Applications”, “Nunavik Syllabics Support 3.3” and inside this folder, double-click on “NunavikSyllabics” to launch the keyboard layout.



You should only need to do this once because after each Restart of your computer, the keyboard layout will launch automatically.



To use the keyboard layout, simply depress the Caps Lock key on your keyboard. When you are not typing in Inuktitut, you can still keep the keyboard layout Enabled.
