



# Policy on Graduation

## Kativik School Board

Adopted by the Council of Commissioners on: June 11, 2001

As per resolution #: 2000/2001-41

Modified on June 20, 2003 by resolution #: 2002/2003-59, and on October 21, 2015 by resolution #2015/16-06.

The School Board believes that it is important to reward students who complete their education and wishes to promote the value of completing education and to encourage other students to stay in school.

### **1) General principle**

1.1 This policy sets the rules pertaining to graduations of students in the School Board's programs.

### **2) Post-Secondary graduates**

2.1 All CEGEP and university graduates are entitled to invite one member of their family or their partner (guest) to their graduation ceremony.

2.2 The School Board assumes the cost of transportation of the guest from his community as well as the cost of room and board not exceeding five (5) days and as per the rates established in the Board Policy on Travel.

### **3) Continuing Education Programs graduates**

3.1 All transfer students who graduates from a KSB Continuing Education Program are entitled to invite one member of their family or their partner (guest) to their graduation ceremony.

3.2 The School Board assumes the cost of transportation of the guest from his community as well as the cost of room and board not exceeding five (5) days and as per the rates established in the Board Policy on Travel.

3.3 A graduation ceremony organized by the local administration may be held in each community for this occasion. An amount of \$100 per graduate is available to cover additional expenses.

- 3.4 Each Adult Education Center may request up to \$200.00 to cover additional expenses.
- 3.5 All graduates of the Vocational Education program and the Secondary School program receive a ring.

#### **4) Regular sector graduates**

- 4.1 All graduates of the secondary 5 program at the regular sector receive a ring.
- 4.2 A graduation ceremony organized by the school administration may be held in each community for this occasion.
- 4.3 An amount of \$100 per student is available to cover additional expenses.
- 4.4 Transfer students graduates are entitled to invite one member of their family or their partner (guest) to their graduation ceremony.
- 4.5 The School Board assumes the cost of transportation of the guest from his community as well as the cost of room and board not exceeding five (5) days and as per the rates established in the Board Policy on Travel.
- 4.6 Each School may request up to \$200 to cover additional expenses.

#### **5) Teacher training graduates**

- 5.1 All graduates of the Teacher Training program receive a gift to be determined by the Department.
- 5.2 The School Board assumes the cost of transportation of the guest from his community as well as the cost of room and board not exceeding five (5) days and as per the rates established in the Board Policy on Travel.

#### **6) Application of this Policy**

- 6.1 The Director-General is the person responsible for the application of this policy.
