**FUNCTION & DUTIES:**

Reporting to the Director of the Post-Secondary department, the Curriculum Development Counsellor will:

- Participate in the development and implementation of curriculum and evaluation reference frameworks in Inuktitut for the Nunavik Sivunitsavut Program;
- Work with a team of Inuktitut teachers at the Post-Secondary level and in consultation with the Curriculum development team in the adult and regular sectors to assure a continuity and consistency in all Kativik Ilisarniliriniq programs;
- Work on the conception of Inuktitut programs and the development of pedagogical material;
- Compile existing resources (literature, dictionaries, films, etc) and render them accessible to students;
- Participate in training sessions and working groups in relation to the implementation of MEES programs per competency;
- Perform other relevant tasks at the discretion of the supervisor.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

Bachelor's degree in a relevant field of specialization such as Education or a graduate of the Kativik Teacher Training Program.

*The Board may, at its discretion, waive any or all of the afore-mentioned qualifications if it finds a suitable candidate who is a beneficiary of the James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement (JBNQA) and who accepts, as a condition of employment, to follow a training plan determined by the Board.*

**REQUIREMENTS:**

Fluency in Inuktitut;  
Excellent writing skills in Inuktitut;  
Experience in curriculum design and development the secondary level.
