Kativik Ilisarniliriniq is a school board offering educational services in the 14 communities of Nunavik.

Under the supervision of the Assistant Director of Second Language Curriculum Development, this position entails the responsibility of providing advice and support to schools in the implementation, development and evaluation of programs of study, class management and instructional materials.

FUNCTION & DUTIES:

- Facilitate and oversee the development of place-based, Inuit-centred curriculum
- Support and ensure high quality and culturally relevant education in Nunavik communities specifically with secondary teachers in math and science;
- Participate in the development of the programs and pedagogical material that are aligned to Inuit culture, language and values;
- Support the KI competency-based program promote it with the school administrators, teachers and other staff members concerned.
- Lead training sessions / workshops with teachers in person or with technological support (virtual class, videoconference and others);
- Develop learning and evaluation situations as well as support material for the secondary level.
- Collaborate with team members across departments and cultures on the development of materials;
- Support specific projects in these teaching fields using creative thinking and problem solving skills;
- Carry out related tasks at the discretion of the immediate supervisor.

QUALIFICATIONS:

University degree in a relevant field; CEGEP or vocational degree or attestation will be considered if applicant is a beneficiary of the James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement.

The Board may, at its discretion, waive any or all of the afore-mentioned qualifications if it finds a suitable candidate who is a beneficiary of the James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement (JBNQA) and who accepts, as a condition of employment, to follow a training plan determined by the Board.

ASSETS:

- *Legal qualification to teach in the province of Québec, or other province of Canada;*
- *Experience as a teacher or youth worker, trainer or experience in trades, or program developer;*
- *Strong computer literacy;*
- *Strong communication, networking, and relationship-building skills;*
- *Knowledge of Inuktitut French and/or English is essential.*

CLASSIFICATION / SALARY / BENEFITS:

In accordance with the SPPOM collective agreement for professionals: from \$46,114 to \$82,585 depending on qualification and experience.
