**FUNCTION & DUTIES:**

- Supporting schools in the implementation of the Compassionate Schools approach (trauma informed practices in schools/ PBIS);
- Supporting teachers and school staff in classroom and behavioural management to ensure school wide consistency to the approach;
- Preparing, presenting and participating in workshops that are relevant to this topic;
- Mentoring team leaders and internal coaches on school teams;
- Must be able to travel frequently throughout Nunavik;
- Any other related tasks as determined by his/her supervisor.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

Bachelor's degree in Education or similar field;  
A minimum of two (2) years of experience in teaching.

*The Board may, at its discretion, waive any or all of the afore-mentioned qualifications if it finds a suitable candidate who is a beneficiary of the James Bay and Northern Québec Agreement (JBNQA) and who accepts, as a condition of employment, to follow a training plan determined by the Board.*

- Work within Kativik School Board would be an asset;
- Experience in working with students with challenging behaviours;
- Good classroom management skills, knowledge of trauma informed practices and experience using reflective teaching practices;
- Knowledge of Positive Behavioural Interventions and Supports (PBIS);
- Meeting facilitation skills and experience leading a group discussion;
- Responsible, open-minded, and aware of Inuit culture/ history;
- Strong work ethic and effective problem solving skills
